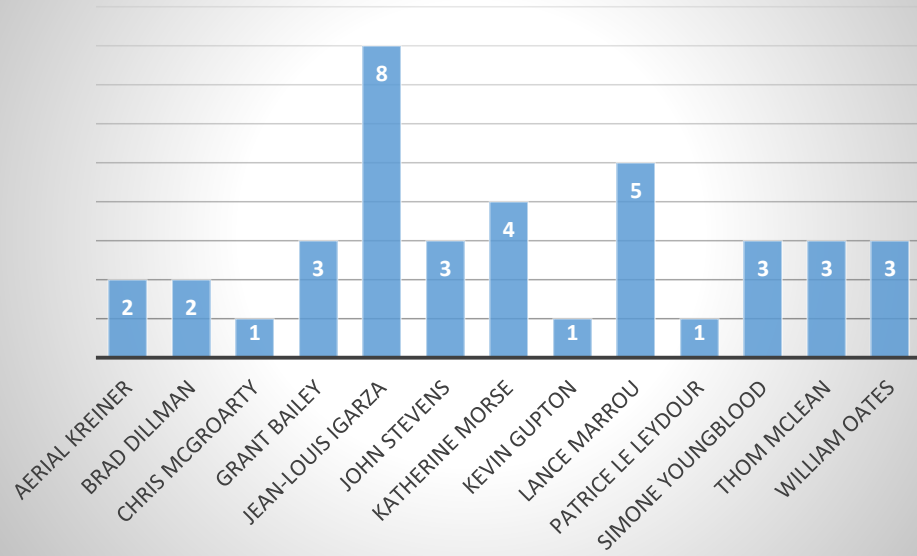


Figure 1 — SAC Member Assignments (08 March 2017)
